The cultural wing titled “**Telugu Basha Sahitya Samskritika Vibhagam**” was established at CCE in 2008. Since, its inception, the cultural wing of the department has been extending guidance and support towards conduct of various activities at different levels, i.e., College, District, Zonal and State level to promote all-round development of the students and unearth their talents. The department conducting various cultural, literary activities in Govt. Degree Colleges till the Academic year 2007.
