**Sub:** CCE A.P – Degree Colleges to be developed as Centres of Excellence in Science, Arts and Commerce Streams – Principals of GDCs identified to be developed as Centres of Excellence under Phase-II to attend workshop at O/o CCE, Hyderabad on 22.07.2014 and thereafter to visit top ranking colleges in Hyderabad along with Academic Coordinators and faculty members from 23.07.2014 to 25.07.2014 – Orders- Reg.

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The Department of Collegiate Education has recognised the need to develop the existing Degree Colleges into Centres of Excellence so that these colleges evolve into preferred institutions specialised in any one/two of the three streams, viz., Science, Arts and Commerce or all the three streams in each district of A.P. Under Phase-I, 37 Government, Aided and Private Unaided Colleges were identified, based on the parameters like infrastructure facilities, faculty and their research experience, results obtained in the respective stream, student strength and best practices followed by the colleges. 14 Government Degree Colleges have been identified to be developed as Centres of Excellence under Phase – II. The list of Government Degree Colleges identified to be developed as Centres of Excellence under Phase - II is appended.

The Principals of GDCs identified to be developed as Centres of Excellence in Science, Arts and Commerce Streams under Phase-II are hereby requested to attend a workshop in the O/o CCE, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, BRKR Bhavan, Hyderabad on 22.07.2014 at 10.00 AM without fail. The Principals are requested to come prepared to present a brief note on the innovative/best practices adopted by their college. They are also directed to tour the colleges in Hyderabad listed among the top 50 colleges in the India Today & Nielsen survey for exchange of ideas and receiving inputs in order to develop their respective institutions into Centres of Excellence along with their Academic Coordinators and Faculty members of the respective stream from 23<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> July 2014. The list of colleges to be visited will be provided at the workshop.

The Principals are also directed to submit proposals for starting 2 new UG courses and 1 PG course based on the local need and demand on or before 22.07.2014. If proposal is already submitted, the same may be informed.

The Principals shall note that attending this workshop and visiting colleges along with his/her team is mandatory on the dates mentioned above. Any deviation will be viewed seriously.
