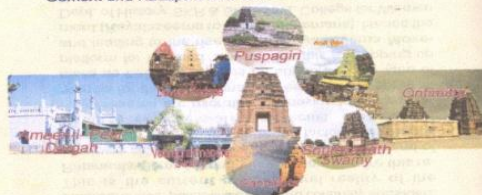

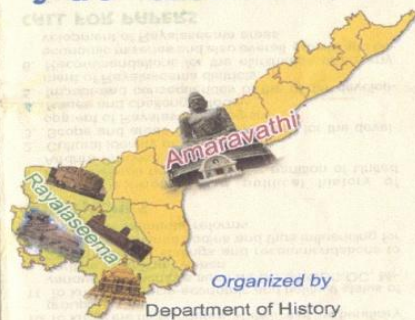

ABOUT THE COLLEGE:

DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY:

Since the inception of the college the Department of History played a responsible role. It was started with a view to cater to the needs of the socially backward and economically weaker students of the backward Rayalaseema region which is drought prone area. There are two members in the department. The Department is unique in the Kadapa district having only English Medium for Womens Students. This is the Department which has more than 400 students in the B.A. Group. The college has a combination for the group of B.A. i.e. History, Economics and Political Science in Telugu and English Medium. In 2008, a structure group in B.A. with the combination of History, Economics and Computer Science was introduced. And in 2015, History, Political Science and Telugu Literature (HPT) has been started.

About the Seminar

Rayalaseema - its identity, development and politics is a burning issue in India emerged during pre and post partition of United Andhra Pradesh and formation of the State of Telangana. It is a focus theme now in order to understand and analyze the socio-economic-cultural-political conditions of the people of Rayalaseema region since the beginning of its civilization and culture. The resources of Rayalaseema are best utilized for the development of United Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad City and certain specific communities whereas the other majority sections of people are wholly and partially neglected. Due to the selfish motives and power politics in the region, the fate of Rayalaseema got unchanged and further has become worst, pathetic and miserable. The definitions of the term development are not known to the people of Rayalaseema that convey social injustice, economic backwardness, political slavery and culturally subsided. This is the current ground level reality of the Ratanaalaseema (during Vijayanagara Empire this region was called as Ratanaalaseema. i.e. the Land of Diamonds). There were so many factors contributed for the backwardness of Rayalaseema. The people of Rayalaseema are migrating or moving to other parts of India for the educational and employment opportunities as because there is no support or any kind of platform for the said. Day by day this is cropping up and leading to the rise of Pan Rayalaseema Movement (Rayalaseema for Rayalaseemans). Hence the Dept. of History, SKR & SKR Govt. College for Women Kadapa, Yogi Vemana University is striving to bring scholars together in a forum to discuss and interact on the specified topic, "Rayalaseema - Identity, Development and Politics from the formation of Andhra State to the partition of Andhra Pradesh in 2014".
