Nagari is a Municipal town in Chittoor District in the Indian State of Andhra Pradesh. Etymologically the word Nagari is from the Hindi Words 'Nak' and 'Giri', which means Hill with Nose. Nagari hills have an elevation of about 855mtrs which resembles a Human Nose. It is Semi Agrarian – Semi Industrialized town. The Nagari Municipality is gateway of Andhra Pradesh from Tamilnadu. It is famous for Cotton Textile products .The people of Nagari speak Telugu and Tamil. A Saibaba's temple which is located on the hilltop very nearer to the Govt. Degree & P.G. College. It has proximity to Tiruttani, the abode of Lord Subramanyam Swamy, to Narayanavanam, the abode of Kalyana Venkateswara Swamy and also to Tirumala, the abode of Lord Venkateswara Swamy. About the Seminar

Both the Central and State Governments launched various poverty alleviation programs since independence for the upliftment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in order to bring them into the main stream of the society through generating self employment and wage employment. But due to illiteracy, ignorance, lack of awareness and exploitation these sections were not able to utilize the welfare and development programmes effectively. As a result these programmes were not achieved desired results. . How well the financial assistance by the formal institutions is being implemented across the state? How far the scheme reaches to the target groups? What are the main constraints faced by the beneficiaries and also implementing agencies? How the SC and ST communities have participated? What type of income generating activities are undertaken and how affective they are etc? Will be addressed in the seminar.

Rationale for Study

The findings and conclusions of the seminar are likely to provide inputs to the planners and administrators in designing new schemes or re-design the present schemes for the development of scheduled caste and scheduled tribes. Further the insights from the seminar will be immensely helpful to the financial institutions in the delivery of the schemes establishment of forward and backward linkages and to carry out further research on different aspects of the welfare and development programs of SC and STs.

Main objective of the Seminar

To assess the impact of Institutional Finance on the Socio-Economic Development of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in Andhra Pradesh.

Sub Themes

- To know the socio-economic background of the beneficiary families in Andhra Pradesh.

- To understand the problems and experiences of beneficiaries in accessing credit and its utilization.
- To assess the impact of credit on the socio-economic conditions of the beneficiaries such as income, savings, asset creation, employment, children's education, health, household expenditure, migration etc.
- To identify the variations in the utilization pattern of credit by various tribal groups and castes.
- Problems and experiences of bankers in grounding the economic assistance schemes, capacity building, training, monitoring and supervision, recovery of the loans etc.
- Problems faced by the SC and ST finance development corporation officers in the implementation of the programs with special reference to economic assistance scheme.
- Types of income generating activities undertaken by the beneficiaries.
- Follow up actions and forward and backward linkages established by the sponsored agencies.
- Entrepreneurial skills among the beneficiaries.
- Performance and progress of state level SC and ST finance corporations in the physical and financial targets and achievements.
- Role and functions of national level finance and development corporations in the upliftment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes
- Reasons for indebtedness among the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
