

About the College:

Silver Jubilee Government College is the only State-wide Residential Degree College established in the year 1972 at Kurnool modeled on the lines of prestigious universities in and outside the country. It is, in fact, a gift to the people of Andhra Pradesh by the Government of India commemorating the Silver Jubilee Celebrations of Indian Independence. The two main goals of establishment of this specially carved out institution are being the provision of qualitative higher education to the meritorious needy students and also to forge emotional integration of the people of the three regions of the erstwhile A P State, namely, Andhra, Telangana and Rayalaseema when its integrity was under threat of separatist tendencies.

The lofty ideals and efforts of the institution started yielding matching results in the performance of the very first batch itself. The alumni of the institution and their academic excellence, professional competence and ethical elegance raised the institutional reputation to the glorious heights. **Sri. I.Y.R. KRISHNA RAO Garu, IAS., The Chief Secretary of Andhra Pradesh hails from this institution as the First Batch student.** The college has chartered its course on the path of academic progress initially offering U.G.Courses (14) and now offering 5 P.G.Courses. The institution envisages enhancing the quality and increasing the enrolment of students of both Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes. With this objective the institute has decided to participate in the schemes chalked out in RUSA.

The college has set its own benchmarks for delivery of quality education and has been conferred Autonomous status by University Grants Commission in 2005 and accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC in 2006. The college has been recognized for its quality service to the stakeholders and has been conferred the status of 'College with Potential for Excellence' by UGC in 2010 and UGC extended Autonomous Status for further next period of six years up to 2016-17. The college went for Re-accreditation by the NAAC in September, 2014, and awarded "A" Grade with 3.30 CGPA which is the highest to any Government Degree Colleges in both Andhra Pradesh and Telangana States so far. The Choice Based Credit System was introduced in 2013-14. Initiatives have been taken to conduct ONLINE internal Examinations in 2014-15. The Co-Education has been introduced from 2014-15 implementing the NAAC

Peer Team Recommendations. The institution has been maintaining the mark of Excellence offering qualitative education to the students.

About Kurnool:

Kurnool District (Telugu: కర్నూలు జిల్లా, Urdu: كَرْنُول ضلع) is a district in the state of Andhra Pradesh, India, located in the west-central part of the state on the southern banks of the Tungabhadra and Handri rivers. The town of Kurnool is currently the headquarters of the district. It is also known as the Gateway to Rayalaseema. Kurnool served as the state capital of Andhra (not Andhra Pradesh) from 1 October 1953 to 31 October 1956. A very famous and lengthy K.C. Canal starts in Kurnool and ends in Cuddapah. It is around 300 kilometers long. In Kurnool city there are a number of ancient temples, churches and mosques. Kurnool city, known as the gateway to the Rayalaseema, on N.H.7.

Places of Interest around Kurnool:

Places of tourist interest such as Kurnool fort, famous Jyothirlinga shrine Sri.Mallikarjuna Swamy temple, Hydroelectric project Rajiv tiger reserve at Srisailem; Mahanandi, Ahobilam, Mantralayam, Jogulamba shaktipeet Temples; ancient Belum caves, are located in a travelling distance of 2 to 3 hours from Kurnool.

About the Department:

The Department of Botany was established in 1972 With BZC group. Later in 1996 Microbiology and 2007 Biotechnology subjects were introduced with Botany combination. The semester system was introduced in 2006-07 and CBCS in 2013-14. The Department is renowned for its research in Medicinal plants, Photochemistry and NAAC. Mushroom Cultivation and Bio-fertilizer Technology are offered under "Earn-While you Learn" programme. The Department is maintaining "Digital Herbarium".

How to reach:

- **By Rail:** Kurnool lies on the Secunderabad–Bangalore railway line.
- **By Road:** Kurnool is well connected to most cities and towns in Andhra Pradesh and to Bangalore and Chennai by APSRTC. N.H.-7 connects it to Hyderabad (210 km, 3.5 hours) and Bangalore (360 km, 6 hours).
