About Nandikotkur

A small town of Nandikotkur is located in Kurnool District of Andhra Pradesh, it is about 30Km. from Kurnool situated on Kurnool - Vijayawada State Highway. The town was built by the Kakathiyas during 12th Century A.D. King Prathapa Rudra gifted Nandikotkur to Sirisingila Deva, his chieftain, Nine Bulls (Navanandis) were erected by this ruler- surrounding the town- along with the local deity KOTUKURAMMA after whose name the present name Nandikotkur got itself derived. Nandikotkur is the gate way to Srisailem a famous Shiva pilgrim center in Kurnool District.

Nandikotkur is traditionally with rural background of the character. The students are mostly from the village background with a very poor socio economic status and heavily depend on wages for their livelihood. This kind of conference would enlighten lot of awareness among the rural students of the local area about their economic scenario.

About the College

In 1946 a government high school was started which grew in to Junior college in 1969 and finally in to the present Degree College, in 1982 with Arts and Commerce groups. Sciences were introduced in 1985. Our college is affiliated to Sri Krishna Devaraya University and now it is under Rayalaseema University, Kurnool, A.P. ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Justice Srikrishna committee declared that Rayalaseema region, which comprises of the districts of Kurnool, Kadapa, Anantapur and Chittoor. The districts are most deprived and backward region of Andhra Pradesh. All the four districts of the Rayalaseema have been suffering from continuous drought conditions due to failure of monsoons. The Planning Commission has also identified the Rayalaseema districts under the Backward Region Grant Fund (BRGF) scheme and covers 74% of the population in Rayalaseema. Rayalaseema is the most disadvantageous in terms of access to any type of irrigation of any type in the state of AP and hence the Rayalaseema region is unable to catch up with the productivity growth compared with other two regions of the erstwhile Andhra Pradesh over the last five decades.

There are variations between regions in such deprivations which are the components of human development. It is Rayalaseema region which has recorded an increase in deprivation during last five decades. With this background, it is decided that the First Pre-Annual Conference of Andhra Pradesh Economic Association would deliberate on 'Problems and Prospectus of Development of Rayalaseema Region of Andhra Pradesh' at Government Degree College, Nandikotkur, Kurnool (Dist) on 24th January, 2015.
