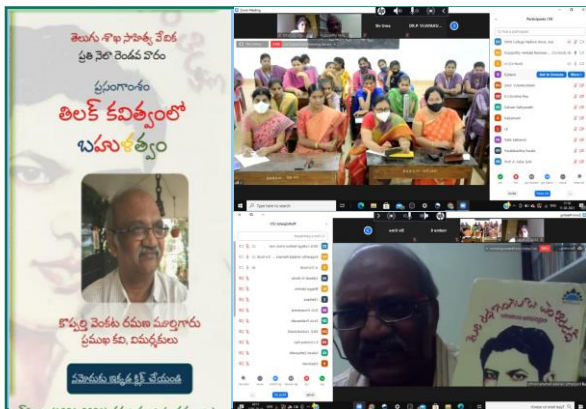

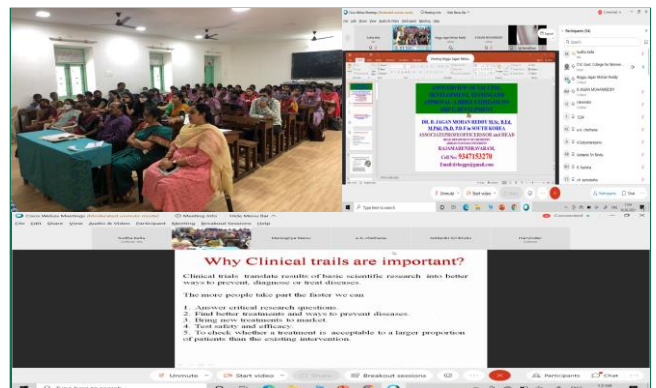
Sahiti Kousalyam

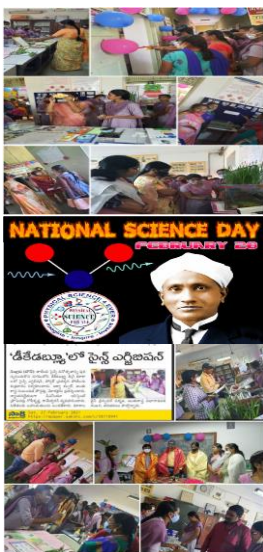
NCC UNIT B and C Examination Cadres
