The Govt. Degree college, Razole is situated nearby the riverlet 'VASISTA' in Razole village which is 80 Kms away from the town Rajahmundry in East Godavary Dist. It is in the greenish area surrounded by coconut trees. The area is popularly known as KONASEEMA in Andhra Pradesh.

The prominent personalities of Razole were anxiously thinking of establishing a degree college in konaseema area . The prominent hands donated and worked for its inception were then Honourable Minister Sri. Rudra Raju Ramalinga Raju, Ms.V.V.Narasamma, the wife of Dr. V.S. Krishna and Mr. B.V.R.Prasad who started to collect donations in the beginning and later on, lead to form a college development committee. With an assurance from the committee for acquiring 10 acres of land for construction of buildings, the Govt. accorded permission for the establishment of the college on 8th August, 1968 vide GO MS NO 1524 Education Department dt. 3-8-1968. At first the college started functioning in Zillah Parishad Higher Secondary School. In August 1970, the college was shifted to the newly constructed buildings. In 1974, a new building was formed and the science faculty was shifted in. In 1991, Library building was inaugurated by the then Regional Joint Director of Higher Education Mr. K.Venkareddy. In 2005, a seminar hall and two class rooms were also opened by the present Razole Constituency M.L.A. Sri. Alluri Krishnam Raju. Our M.L.A has been pleased to take steps for granting 40 lakhs for the construction of compound wall and nine class rooms, which are in progress. Sri.P.Hanumantha Rao, senior lawyer, has been supervising the work and also advising on all matters relating to college development in the capacity of the member of the C.P.D.C.

The college has now been functioning in three blocks namely 1.Commerce 2 Arts and 3. Science. The departments of science, the office of the Principal, the Administrative Office and Staff-rooms are housed in a pucca building the library, seminar hall and two class rooms are in the first floor of the building.

From 1968 to 1971, instruction was imparted to PUC and Degree classes as per the syllabi prescribed by the Andhra University, Waltair and later by Adikavi Nannaya University Rajamahendravara , to which the college was affiliated. The college imparted instruction in Telugu Medium for classes with the following combinations

1. History, Economics , Political Science, Computer Science
2. Commerce with computers
3. Mathematics ,Physics, Chemistry and Computer Science
4. Botany , Zoology and Chemistry.

Over the last three decades the college had made rapid strides under the able guidance of the stalwarts worked as principals of the college and dedicated members of the teaching and non-teaching staff.

In October 1997, Dr B.R. Ambedkar Open University started a study center with senior member Mr A. Rama Krishna, Lecturer in Chemistry as Co-ordinator , and counseling the classes for B.A students at this center.

In the field of Physical Education the students of the institution participated in university tournaments and won prizes .

The N.S.S Students also achieved remarkable progress and served the society by arranging programmes like blood donation, special camps for the upgradation of village environment and other social activities .

Though the students belong to rural area they have been trying hard in enriching their knowledge in educational field besides being assisting their families by involving themselves in agricultural works .
