1. All the District Coordinators should bring Rolling Shields of your concern district colleges on 24.11.2014.
2. All the District Cultural & Sports Coordinators are instructed to send the photographs of best performance in the District Level Competitions along with details for the preparation of PPT at Yuvatharangam-2014 Festival to **yuvatharangam.cce@gmail.com**
3. All the participants must accompanied by the District Coordinators/Team Managers/Responsible persons along with Identity Cards duly attested by the Principal.
4. All the participants should come with their own equipment for all events.
5. One participant should participate in one event only.
6. For Essay writing, Elocution and spot painting, the topics will be announced on hour before the competition. For Essay Writing Competition white papers will be given by the organisers. Students will come with their writing pads. For Spot painting competition only drawing charts will be given. Students should bring their own material related to the competition.
7. For Chukkala Muggu competition only chukkala Muggulu will be allowed. Students should come prepare with the related material.
8. Limited accommodation is available. Hence the Lecturers/Team Managers/Accompanists will only be given accommodation.
9. No night stay is allowed either Team Managers/Accompanists or students. Hence it is requested to make alternate arrangements.
10. The state level competitions results will be placed in CCE's website after the completion of all the competitions.
11. The participants, accompanying Lecturers/Team Managers/Accompanists will be provided breakfast, lunch, tea and snacks on the day of the competition.

STATE LEVEL LITERARY EVENT - QUIZ COMPETITION

GENERAL RULES :

- 1) All the teams and audience are strictly instructed to maintain strict silence.
- 2) Each team will be asked one question in each round and for correct answer 2 points will be awarded. No negative points for wrong answers.
- 3) No points will be awarded for incorrect/partial answers.
- 4) If a team is asked a question and does not answer it correctly, the question will be handed over to the other team to answer. If the second/third/..... team (in prescribed way) answers correctly, they are awarded with 1 point.
- 5) The questions are in the form of Specific-answers only and *no multiple choice questions(MCQ's)*
- 6) Every team will be advised to maintain their own score sheet.
- 7) No participant/team is allowed to use mobile or other electronic gadgets
- 8) Audience shall not give any hints or clues to any teams.
- 9) Replacement of any participant of any team is not allowed at any stage
- 10) Team discussion is allowed, but the **only team leader** is permitted to give the answer and it is **considered as final**.
- 11) All the teams should wear neat formal dress with photo identity cards issued by College Principal.
- 12) *As this quiz is under the control of Video coverage of MANA TV ,every participant/team/audience should abide the instructions of MANA TV in-charges.*
- 13) All the teams should adhere with any changes/ rules/regulations time to time while conducting the quiz.
- 14) **The decision of the representative of CCE /quiz-master will be final and will not be subjected to any change.**

Details of Conducting the QUIZ :

- I. There are **13 rounds** comprises in the following model areas namely
 - 1) **Current affairs**
 - 2) **Books and Authors**
 - 3) **Telugu Literature**
 - 4) **Politics**
 - 5) **History**
 - 6) **Sciences**
 - 7) **Computers**
 - 8) **Geography/Economics**
 - 9) **Mythology**
 - 10) **Sports**
 - 11) **Photos**
 - 12) **Business**
 - 13) **Entertainment & others etc.,**
- II. In each round 13 questions are framed in all sub areas at all levels.
- III. Time for each question is 30/20 seconds.
- IV. No time will be given for pass on teams.
- V. In the last round questions are framed from various fields which not covered in the above specified broad areas.
- VI. First round starts with team A, second round starts with team B, third round with team C ... last 13 th round starts with team M and the same will be announced before the quiz starts.
- VII. Any other regulations should follow from time to time....
- VIII. If any tie exists for selecting the winners/runners , surprise **RAPID FIRE QUESTION ROUND** will be conducted only for those teams are in tie .
